## Module 10: Summary & conclusion

- Set a budget and get the best equipment you can afford now. You can always upgrade later. Because you're logging your finds you can always go back when you upgrade.
- Master your detector through reading the manual several times and practicing a lot. Experiment with different settings. Research online and engage with others on forums to get tips.
- Always use a pinpointer and hunt efficiently to increase good finds.
- Be aware of the site your detecting and use the best settings, coil, and sweep speed for the best advantage.
- Learn to be resourceful with your research methods and utilize a variety of sources, both local and online.
- Use the blanket strategy for finding many potential sites to hunt. Take a systematic approach to covering every part of your geographic area.
- Try to think outside the box and know that any grassy area could be a productive site and worth investigating as long as it's in an old area.
- Find what works best in your area. Experiment, try different methods and places to determine what's most productive.
- Don't be afraid to sidewalk hunt or knock doors to ask for permission. Many detectorists avoid these two areas so it will give you a significant advantage if you can muster the courage. Don't think about it, just do it!
- Keep a log of all your finds.
- Constantly strive to better your knowledge and ability of the hobby
